Schunke on LDS

The following is a partial table of contents and guide to the material in a set of 23 Church of Latter Day Saints (LDS) films (called "Rolls" below) of genealogical materials collected by Marjorie Schunke, a genealogical researcher in Rhode Island. Schunke is known particularly as a researcher of the Worden and Webster families and also studied many other Rhode Island families. The films are held in LDS facilities in Salt Lake City but have been made available on the web at:

The material on these rolls is at the North Kingstown Free Library in Rhode Island (NKFL). The rolls were filmed at the Rhode Island State Archives in Providence.

LDS files (called here “Rolls”) are usually made up of one or more “Items” which in turn are made up of “Images,” that is, individual pictures of materials. Images are numbered from the beginning of the roll. MWS’s materials are of various sorts, much is handwritten charts or notes. Others are typed, either by MWS or others. Some is printed from books or journals. Some are pictures or maps. Occasionally there is material having no genealogical significance such as recipes or newspaper clippings MWS found interesting. There is a very large amount of repetition in the following. Sometimes the replication occurs right after a image appears, but there is also a fair amount of replication across rolls. The rolls sometimes have a END OF ROLL indication followed by more material ending in a real END OF ROLL. This additional material is usually repetitions of the last one or two items before the first END OF ROLL.

Much of the handwritten material seems disordered and of little use, her own notes to herself. Sometimes related material is bunched together but often there appears to be little sense to the order of material. Rolls and items have title pages that may or may not reflect what follows.

MWS sometimes used what I call “wrapped charts,” that is, a standard ancestral chart in which the top and bottom are continuous, the most recent individual at the bottom right (most distant at upper right). MWS used several variations of this chart often interrupting the flow with notes on individuals.

I have had the experience of seeing the image numbers change from one viewing to another but as of this writing this has not happened for a while.

The NKFL has developed guides to a small amount of this material. These guides may be accessed at the Worden Family Association website. Where relevant I have provided below a cross reference to that material, beginning with “[SEE . . .]”. References below to “Boxes” or “Volumes” have little meaning in the context of the LDS rolls but may be relevant to the NKFL holdings. I have not examined the material at NKFL.

To navigate the LDS rolls:

After accessing the main site (address above) a particular roll may be accessed by clicking on the camera icon at the right of the entry. LDS films usually have sections called “Items,” within Items are “Images.” Images are numbered from the beginning of the roll. A few images on each roll are for LDS housekeeping, a few are headings for material that follows, which may or may not actually reflect the material that follows.

Once you are viewing the relevant roll you will either be looking at a single image or a screen full of images. You can toggle between these with the menu at the left edge of the screen (the vertical bar with + and - , below which is an icon of either a page or collection, this is the icon that toggles). Above that vertical bar is “Image x of y” where y is the number of images on the roll and x is the image you are currently focused on. To go to a particular image on the roll, go to the x slot, erase the number and put in the number of the image you want then hit “Enter”. The right and left arrows move to the next or preceding images. The mouse wheel can be used to enlarge or reduce the image.

I have provided here an almost complete table of contents of the first roll and a fair amount of the second roll. After that I have provided an account of the first few entries and (usually) the last few entries in each item together with an unsystematic sampling of the rest of the roll. I have examined each of the tables of contents (often labeled “Index”) and attempted to give an assessment of them. Sometimes the TofCs are useful, other times they have little to do with the material that follows.
